Æ pragmatics: the study of the expression of relative distance (Yule 2002) Pragmatics investigates the relationship between linguistic forms and their uses (purpose, goal, intention) • use of language for interaction = the interpersonal function • interaction usually has a communicative intention of small talk; phatic function of language
